April 24/25 L&L - EFFICIENCY MANITOBA 200 Main Event Centre (Winnipeg)

Efficiency Manitoba presented to RRMBA Members about the Indigenous Small Business Program, available to Métis-owned businesses registered on the Red River Métis Business Directory.

Eligible applicants receive direct install upgrades, a lighting assessment, and the applicable lighting retrofits. Similar to the Small Business Program, this initiative offers both basic and premium upgrade options—and for majority Métis-owned businesses, both tiers are 100% covered.

Recap of RRMBA Lunch & Learn Events in Q1 (April 2025 to June 2025)


April 9/25 - Métis Employment & Training (MET) 200 Main Event Centre (Winnipeg)

Métis Employment & Training (MET) presented on the Targeted Wage Subsidy Program (TWS)—an initiative that supports sustainable employment by combining on-the-job training with wage subsidies. The program helps Red River Métis job seekers gain valuable work experience while supporting employers with recruitment and training costs.

During the presentation, MET staff also shared information about summer employment opportunities and how they can assist businesses with HR and recruitment support.

Plans are already in motion for continued collaboration with MET to build on the strong connections made this past Spring.


May 22/25 - RRMBA Benefits Program, presented by Linda Branconnier (Priority Financial) 200 Main Event Centre (Winnipeg)

This event also marked an exciting milestone—it was the first RRMBA Mixer hosted in a Red River Métis-owned and operated establishment. Whenever possible, we prioritize venues owned by Red River Métis entrepreneurs, and we were fortunate that the Thirsty Lion could accommodate the June 5 event.


